#### **A. CONCLUSION**

7. Exploring the connections among ideas (even unrelated ideas).
8. Developing a new conception of what a writer is writing about by radiating his ideas.
9. Demolishing fear that hinders a writer.

Accordingly, freewriting encourages a writer to write freely without stopping at amount of time. It helps a writer to show his nature by:

1. Helping a writer to write naturally.
2. Getting the brain in gear.
3. Remembering blocks of information.
4. Finding a topic.
5. Specifying and focusing ideas or topic, especially in focused freewriting.
6. Showing a writer's creative performance by free associating words to words.

As a matter of fact, brainstorming and freewriting have similarities in their basic concepts. Here, the writer finds that both technique uses free association of the right brain. Creativity aspects are emphasized to support their work. It means that the process involves of our nature.
