ABSTRACT

RUTIN MEDIANTI: "THE APPLICATION OF DIALOGUE TECHNIQUE AND ITS CORRELATION WITH THE STUDENTS' MASTERY IN ENGLISH VOCABULARY AT THE SECOND YEAR OF SMPN II BALAPULANG-TEGAL"

One of the problem from the students when they have to remembering many new words they become confused and bored because they do not know the meaning of each words and they can not speaking fluently in English because their lack in vocabulary. So as a teacher must be able to choose appropriate technique one of these technique is dialogue technique trough dialogue the teacher and the students can interact of each other and the main aim of dialogue technique is how to make the students able to understand or can memorize about the real materi so the student able to developed their knowledge.

The aims of research from the thesis are to obtain data about the student's response by using dialogue technique, the students mastery in English vocabulary and the correlation between the using of dialogue technique with the students vocabulary mastery.

The steps in this research is based on theoretical data resources and empirical data resources with 240 students population, and 48 students (20%) as the research sample by means of random sampling. The technique of collecting data used by the writer is observation, questionnaire, interview and test.

After analyzing the data, the writer concludes that the students' response by using dialogue technique is 39 students so more than half of students has positive response, the students mastery in English vocabulary by using dialogue technique has average 73 its mean that the students have high score and the correlation between of using dialogue technique with the students mastery in English vocabulary has average 0.50 its means "sufficient" correlation. The calculation by using "r" table 0.50 in significant 5% is 0.288 and 1% is 0.372 ($r_{xy} > r$ table) its means r_{xy} higher than "r" table and by using "t" test formulation the result is 3.616 in significant 5% is 2.021 and in significant 1% is 2.704 (t jt table) its shows that "t" test bigger than t table.
