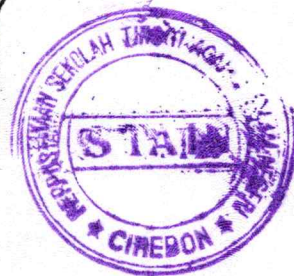

ABSTRACT

IDA FARIDA. **The Correlation between the Students' Mastery of English Vocabulary and Their Ability in Writing Short Conversation at the Second Year Students of *MTs Bahrul Ulum Tasikmalaya***

The total number of words are called vocabulary. Vocabulary is one of the language components in order to carry out communication or to make up a language, so the English vocabulary is therefore very crucial in the process of learning a foreign language. The word writing derives from the verb 'write', which means make letters or other symbols on a surface, especially with a pen or pencil on paper. In line with this case, writing is the activity to make letters or other symbols on a surface with a pen or pencil on pieces of paper.

Based on the background above the writer interested to research how far the correlation between the mastery of vocabulary and writing skill. Factually, the writer would like to know how far the students' mastery of English vocabulary influenced to the students' ability in writing short conversation.

The aim of the research is to find out the data about the students' mastery of English vocabulary, the data about the students' ability achievement in writing short conversation, and the data about the correlation between the students' mastery of English vocabulary and the students' ability achievement in writing short conversation.

The research of the thesis uses empirical technique and uses qualitative and quantitative approach. This research is based on the theoretical data resources and empirical data resources with 29 students of *MTs Bahrul Ulum Awipari – Tasikmalaya* as a sample. Because total population more than 100, so the researcher use one class of the population as a sample. It is called a population sampling.

The result of computation of two variables (the students' mastery of English vocabulary and students' ability in writing short conversation) shows the score 0.50. It is included sufficient correlation. It means that there is significant correlation between the students' mastery of English vocabulary as variable X and students' ability in writing short conversation as variable Y.





AUTOBIOGRAPHY

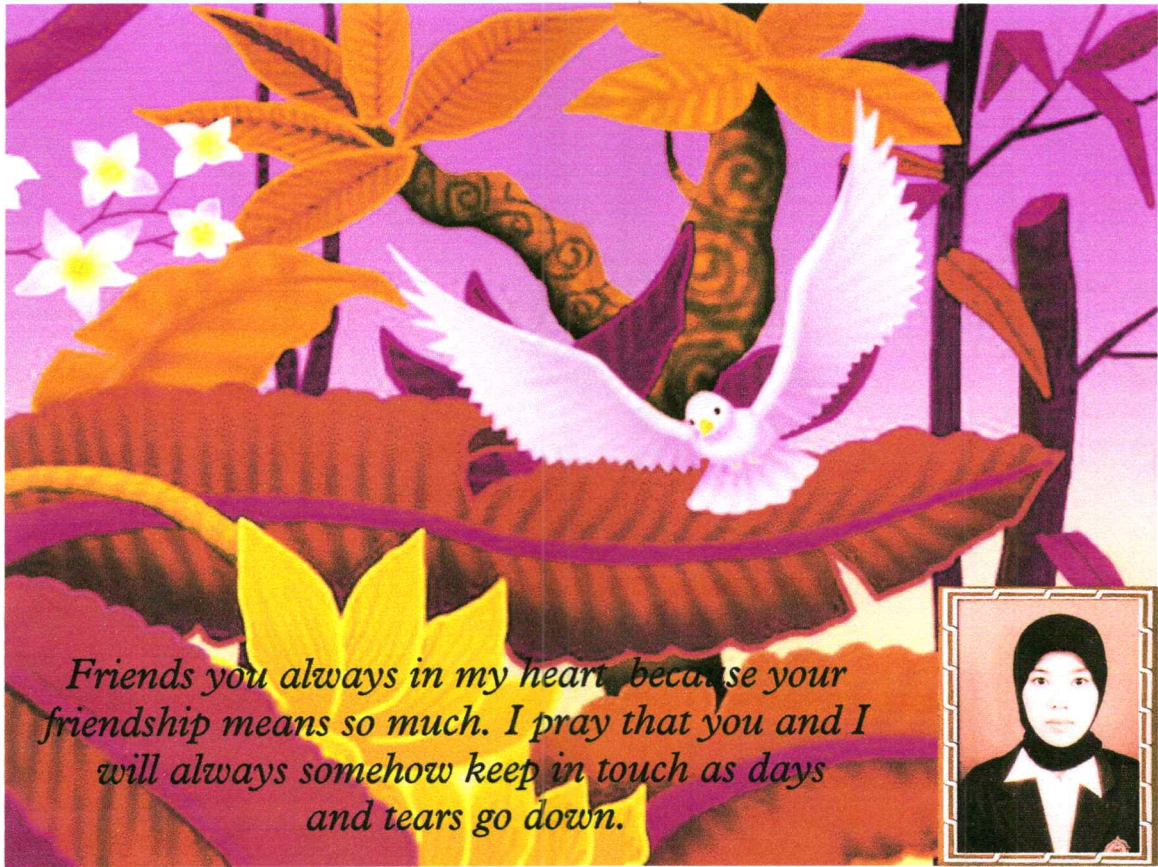

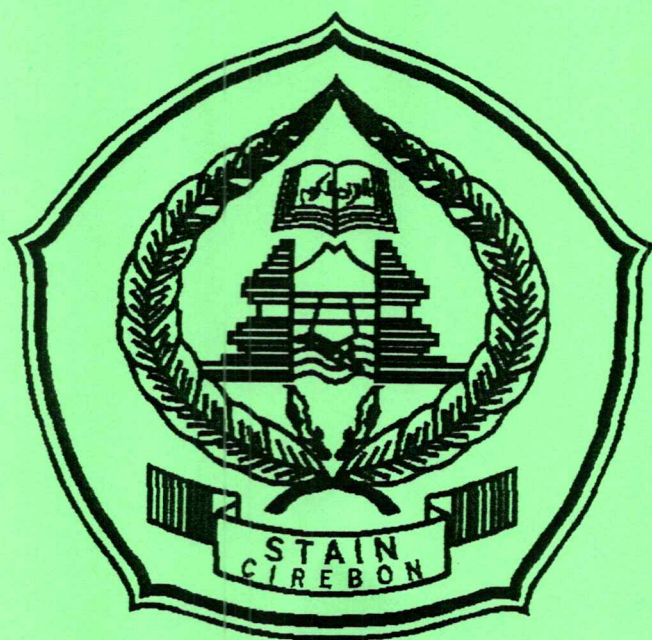


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
