ABSTRACT

GILAR DARMAWAN: The Correlation Between Students' Mastery in Grammar and Their Reading Comprehension at The First Year of State Islamic Senior High School (MAN) Awipari Tasikmalaya.

To understand English Reading, the students are demanded to master not only vocabulary but also the grammar. It is a must because the students may not be able to understand the material content without the rule of the language, and it is grammar. The students must master reading comprehension ability, because much original knowledge is written in English. They can enrich their knowledge that support their lesson in their school by reading activity. They can read not only knowledge in of education but also beyond educational information.

The purpose of this research is to know the data about the students' achievement in grammar and the data about their achievement in reading comprehension. Both of data is calculated to find the result of the correlation between Students' mastery in grammar and their reading comprehension.

Theoretically, students' achievement in grammar will support their ability in reading comprehension. The students will be easy to understand the English reading and find the information well if they master grammar.

In this research, the writer needs the original data of students' achievement in Grammar and reading comprehension. Grammar data is found by using test and so is reading comprehension. The students are given 10 questions for grammar and 10 questions for reading comprehension. The population of the first year of MAN Awipari Tasikmalaya is 120 and the writer takes the sample 40 students.

After the data has been analyzed, the writer knows that the average score of the students' mastery in grammar as variable x is 7.52 and the average score of the students' comprehension in reading is 0.40. On the scale, this score is between 0.40 - 0.70. It means that there is enough or sufficient correlation between variable x and variable y.
