A. CONCLUSION

- The results of the research are that the mean score achieved by the students taught
 Present Continuous Tense through Total Physical Response (TPR) (X1 variable) is
 8.7 for mean score and categorized satisfied
- 2. Similarly, the mean score achieved by the students taught Present Continuous Tense through picture (X2 variable) is 8.6 and also categorized satisfied.
- 3. It means that the teaching of the present continuous tense through TPR is as satisfactory achieved as through picture. The result of 'tobserved' is 0.024. If we take a look at the critical value of 't-table' with the significance 5% with df = 20, the t-table is 2.09. tobserved is 0.024 and it is lower than table or tobserved < table. It means that there is no significant comparison between the two variables above. In conclusion, the writer finds that the alternative hypothesis is rejected and the null hypothesis is accepted
