

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

- The students' achievement in learning English Vocabulary of students' nine age in the fourth grade students of SDN 4 Klenganan – Cirebon as the experimental group can be conclude that the highest score is 8.0 is categorized as “excellent”, the lower score is 3.0, and it is categorized as “fail”. The mean of the result of the students' achievement in English vocabulary is 5.566.
- The students' achievement in learning English Vocabulary of students' ten age in the fourth grade students of SDN 4 Klenganan – Cirebon as the controlled group can be conclude that the highest score is 10.0, is categorized as “excellent”, the lower score is 6.0 and it is categorized as “enough”. The mean of the students' achievement in English vocabulary is 7.666.
- There is a comparison between the students' achievement in learning vocabulary of English subject at 9 and 10 ages. It is proved by the result of the calculation of the 't-observed' (2.27) is higher than the critical value of 't-table' (2.05) with the significance 5% and the degree of freedom 28. While at the level significance 1% is 2.76. This means that the null hypothesis (H_0) stated by the writer is accepted because the testing hypothesis which is done by using “t-test” formula indicates that the value of “t-observed” (2.27) is higher than the critical value of “t-table” (2.05) with the significance 5% and the degree of freedom (df) 28.
