

ABSTRACT

YENI SURYANI: THE CONTRIBUTION OF ENGLISH MORPHOLOGY INTO INDONESIAN VOCABULARY

There are many languages have contributed to our language. One of them is English. English is as a main foreign language of our country is more influence than any other. It is really useful in developing the Indonesian language, mainly in developing the Indonesian vocabulary, where the forms of English words and affixes, as the parts of English morphology are much absorbed into Indonesian vocabulary.

The questions of this research involve how are English and Indonesian morphology, are there any distinctions between them? And how far the contribution of English morphology into Indonesian vocabulary, seen from the view of morphological study.

Being an international language, English morphology is often used as the source of references in enriching the vocabulary of one language.
