

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION

#### A. Conclusion

1. After doing the research, the writer found out noun and adjective phrases that exist in songs album “Thank You Allah” by Maher Zain. The writer found 279 noun phrases and 21 adjective phrases. However, those findings only concern in analyzing two kinds of phrases that include in head modifier phrase. Noun phrases that have been found and analyzed in Maher Zain’s songs are noun phrase which the head is noun and with various modifiers. The modifier can be various adjective such as descriptive adjective, determiner, quantifier, possessive, participle adjective and so on. So does adjective phrases that have been found and analyzed are adjective phrases with adjective as its head. It can be modified by intensifier or comparator.
2. To know and determine kinds of phrase is needed categoizing the phrase structres into their word classes in which this is called by syntactic analysis. The syntactic analysis of noun and adjective phrases in Maher Zain’s songs that have been done are process in which the writer categorizes every word or stem into their word classes to determine whether head and modifier so that it is clear and easier to find kinds of phrase.

#### B. Suggestion

It is important to know phrase, kinds of phrase, its function, syntactic rules of phrase, by learning it through reading texts, grammar books, or others in order that we

can express English structurally correct and avoid wrong position in using phrases. For more fun, we can learn phrases through songs. It is not suggested only for the reader but also anyone who learn English, students' college who take English as their field, and of course for the writer it self. Lastly, the writer suggests to other or later researcher that will research phrases to describe it more comprehensive than this thesis in order to enrich knowledge of syntax especially about phrases.
