CONCLUSION

Conclusion

Based on the analysis of the research findings found out in the field, finally we the writer can draw conclusion about the students influence of using participatory approaches in reading comprehension.

- To know the students knowledge towards influence participatory approaches with the help of the English teacher at *SMPN 1 Krangkeng-Indramayu*, the writer gave the questionnaire to the seventh grade students at the cluster. The total score of the students response in participatory approaches is 2296. The average score of the questionnaire $2296 : 37 = 62.05$. This score can be categorized is good. The application of participatory approaches is sufficient. It shows that the students' response on using participatory approaches in reading comprehension is good. But some of them find difficulties in learning English, especially, about reading comprehension.
- To know the students' achievement in reading comprehension by using participatory approaches, with the help of the English teacher at *SMPN 1 Krangkeng-Indramayu*, the writer gave the objective test to the seventh grade students. The total score of the students' achievement in reading comprehension is 2595. The average score of the test is $2595 : 37 = 70.13$

This score can be categorized is good. But some of them find difficulties in learning reding comprehension.

- As has been know that the result of the questionnaire of the students' response by using participatory approaches is 62.05, and the result of the objective test of the students' achievement in reading comprehension is 70.13. It indicates that by using participatory approaches gives affects to the students achievement in reading comprehension. From the calculation result index correlation "r" product moment shows 0.58. This score can be categorized is good. Its mean that there is enough correlation between the influence of using participatory approaches (X variable) and students' achievement in reading comprehension (Y variable).
