ABSTRACT

Linda Nuramaliyah. 2008103012. Developing A CEFR-Aligned Digital Storybook for Junior High School Students': Engaging the Virtues of The Prophet Muhammad to Build Students' Moral Ethics

Based on the English proficiency index, Indonesia has a low English language proficiency which is ranked 79th out of 113 countries. PISA score reports that students' reading literacy results were at a low level. In addition, there are behaviours that reflect the moral degradation of students, such as bullying, disobeying school rules, cheating in exam, disrespecting teachers and school staff. Seeing this phenomenon, the researcher realized that education in Indonesia needs to change. The researcher decided to create a digital technology-based product that contains stories and convey moral messages to students, using Reading for Emotion stage to compose the text and applied the CEFR levels. The aims of the research is to provide a digital learning resource that can be used effectively in English learning that support students' exploration process, that present inspirational stories that tell figure who have the best character as humans with moral messages in it. The method of the research is qualitative method, used Research and Development design. The research finding shows this digital learning resource can be used as an effective learning media and supports student-centred learning. Teachers feel that digital learning resource is a new breakthrough and can facilitate English learning in class. Students become more interested in learning English, and understand the moral message of the story in the digital learning resource. Furthermore, by using new approaches and technology in learning, it can help students gain new knowledge and experience.
