CHAPTER IV CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter explains the conclusions of the study by summarizing the entire study, this chapter also answers the research questions posed at the beginning of the study (Chapter I). The findings presented are about the characteristics video learning material of Agreement and Disagreement Expression. The characteristics of the video learning material made for the seventh grade of junior high school level. Conclusions also lead to suggestions and recommendations given to related parties.

4.1. Conclusion

4.2. Suggestions

Only the product's original form or the product's development stage is covered by this research. Trials or experiments on these products are required for future study. Moreover, user comments are not gathered. Therefore, this is a flaw in the manufactured product. So, the limits of the material do not promote the practice and development of various speaking abilities. For the creation of a better instrument, additional research can be done on a wider range of speaking abilities and techniques.
