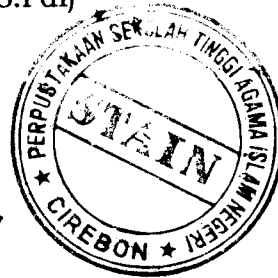
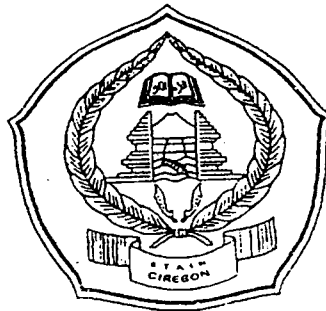

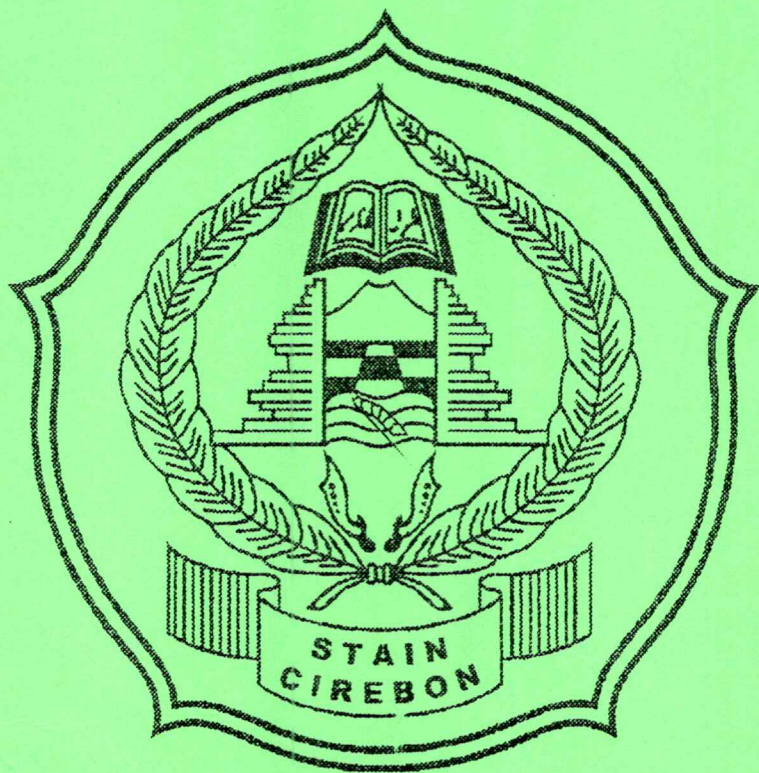

## ABSTRACT

### **Imas Hanipah. The Influence of “Group Work” To The Students’ Motivation In Speaking For The Second Year Students of SMP 1 Cililin Bandung.**

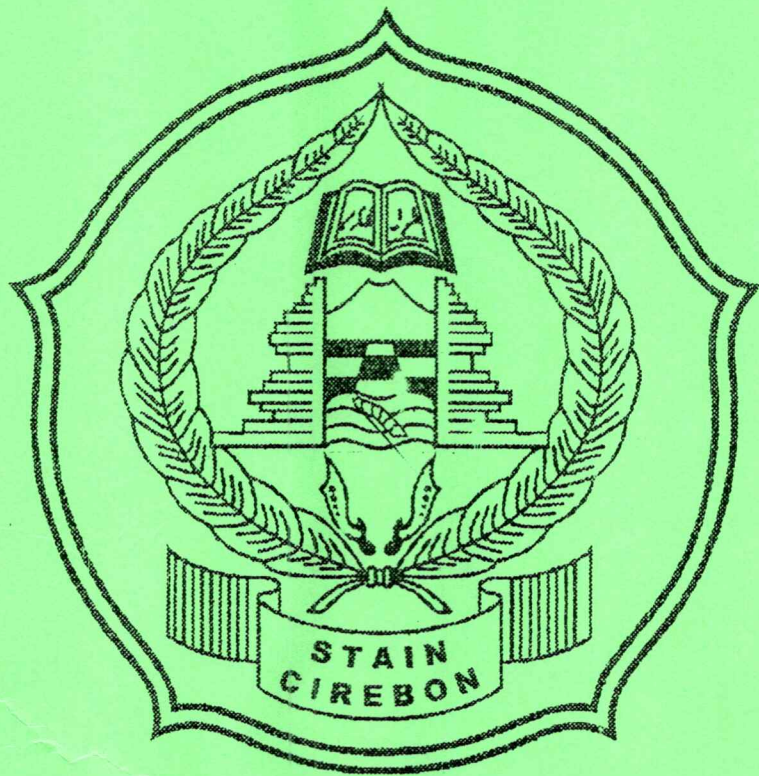
English is one of the important languages in the world. English has been decided as the international language because it is used and spoken by many people in the world. In our country, English is taught to the students from the fourth year of elementary school up to the university. Even though English has been taught to the second year students of SMP 1 Cililin Bandung since they have been taught in the fourth year of elementary school up till now, they still face the difficulties in speaking English. The problem appears probably because their motivation in speaking is still weak. In order to improve the students’ motivation in speaking, the teacher needs the appropriate technique in the process of teaching and learning, includes the “Group Work”.

The aim of this research is to find out the data about the students’ response in “Group Work”, to find out the data about the students’ motivation in speaking, and to know the correlation between students’ response in “Group Work” and the students’ motivation in speaking.

Theoretically, “Group Work” encourages the students to speak and gives much opportunity to speak with minimum intervention from the teacher. So, they can communicate easily and freely.

To find out all of the data on this research, the writer used several techniques, namely: field research and library research. On the field research, the writer gives the questionnaire to the students. And also the writer has done interview to the headmaster, teacher and administration staffs about everything she needs as a source of information for the research.

The conclusion of this research is there is a significant and positive correlation between the students’ response in “Group Work” and the students’ motivation in speaking. The correlative coefficient by using product moment formulation is 0,778 and by using “t” test formulation the correlative coefficient is 8,310. The result is  $r > r_{table}$  and  $t > t_{table}$ . And the level of the influence of “Group Work” to the students’ motivation in speaking is up to 37,2%. It means that there is 62,8% of other factors that influences the students’ motivation in speaking.




