

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

Based on the result of the research, the writer draws some conclusions relating to the students' response in "Group Work" and the students' motivation in speaking for the second year students of SMP 1 Cililin Bandung as follows:

1. To find out the students' response in "Group Work", the writer gives questionnaire to the second year students of SMP 1 Cililin Bandung, which consist of twenty questions (positive and negative questions). So, after the writer collected the data and counted it, the mean result of the students' response in "Group Work" is 70,34. It means that most of the students have good response in "Group Work".
2. To find out the students' motivation in speaking, the writer also gives questionnaire to the second year students of SMP 1 Cililin Bandung which consist of twenty questions (positive and negative questions). So, after the writer collected the data and counted it, the mean result of the students' motivation in speaking is 73,57. In other words the students' response in "Group Work" implicate to their motivation in speaking.
3. Finally, the writer knows that there is a significant and positive correlation between the students' response in "Group Work" and the students' motivation in speaking. It can be seen from the result of the correlation between those two

variables which already counted by using product moment correlation. The result of the correlation is 0,778. It means that it is a strong or high correlation. So, by using product moment (r) the correlative coefficient is 0,778 and by using 't' test formulation, the correlative coefficient is 8,310. The result is $r > r_{table}$ and $t > t_{table}$. And the level of the influence of "Group Work" to the students' motivation in speaking is up to 37,2%. It means that 62,8% of the other factors that influences the students' motivation in speaking.
