There is an adequate number of references. However, some in-text citations do not follow the APA format.

Additional comments along the following lines: originality, literature review, methodology, evaluation of results, research implications, quality of communication, etc.:

The design was not clear enough. An operational framework could have been presented where the variables and steps in the study are shown and applied to the 4D model. Please consider coming up with a framework of the methodology.

The researcher did not adequately explained the sampling procedures, how many students and parents were involved in the study, the timeline, and the composition of the experts. Need more details about the research subjects and the data collection technique. What procedures were followed, and analysis procedures for the qualitative data

Likewise, an image of the traditional games-based parenting model should be included for better representation.

The presentation of the interview results can be done in a more thematic manner instead of by the type of interviewer. Please consider presenting the questions one by one, and the responses of the different interviewees per

question. In this way, we can easily see the differences in perspectives.

It was not also clear how the findings of the interviews were incorporated into the model.

Was the model revised after the assessment? What adjustments were made considering the results of the experts' assessment?

The discussion part does not make adequately discuss the results of the data gathering vis-a-vis the literature. The current discussion part is more of a literature discussion rather than a comprehensive interpretation of the results.

The conclusion part states that This paper concludes that the traditional games-based parenting model is very significant because it can grow an awareness of the importance of in particular, the transmission of Cirebon's cultural heritage" where this did come from? what is the basis of saying "very significant" The conclusion should stay focus on the original intent of the paper.

What are the researchers' recommendations? The current recommendations are also vague. " The recommendation of this research is to develop model materials which are more comprehensive and tiered with a view to the age span at PAUD." what is the basis for this?

- Restate idea "suggestions for improvement until this model can be stated as suitable to be categorized as 'good'"
- Check the tense used for the Validation process stated in the Abstract "After the parenting model has been designed, this model subsequently goes through a validation phase".
- student perceptions [students' perceptions]; can not [cannot],
- The word "traditional" is repeated in the last part of the Abstract.
- This idea is not clear "can be seen in the level of Pre-school aged children's Education Gross Participation Figures (APK – Angka Partisipasi Kasar) in 2019-2020 of 41.18 % or 19 118 894 pupils (Kemendikbud, 2020)". Restate it.
- Check coherence in the composition (e.g: "there are only several"; "Even though parenting as a mode of passing on of culture is very important to do as noted by Zhang, Poston, Alvard, & Cherry (2013) that inheriting culture can be done in two ways,". Check coherence and punctuation in all this paper.
- Punctuation is an aspect that should be considered and checked carefully "e. g: "At the minimum there are five models of child rearing according to Luo et al. (2020) that is,..."".
- Check spelling (e.g: "prinicipal"; "multidimensial")
- The word "according" is overused in the introduction (para. 2), mainly. Change by synonyms, and enrich the use of reporting verbs in all the paper. The same for the word "culture" (use more reference pronouns and restate ideas to avoid repetition of words).
- The poor use of connectors, transition, and linking words, and punctuation make writing mechanical and affects coherence.
- Ideas like this "While Niglio (2014), says that the inheriting of culture is a human process of studying culture which continues as long as there is life." are fragmented; and therefore, uncoherent. (check the use of while).

- Check APA format for in-text citations (and the use of "and", and ampersand "&").
- Check subject-verb agreement "Wu et al. (2020) emphasizes"
- Use reference words to refer back to the same author/s in the same paragraph to avoid repetition (e. g: "Kosim et al. (2021)"; "(Rerey et al., 2019)")
- This author "Budiartati" is written in different forms in the text and in the list of references. Check.
- Check alphabetical order in the references (letter N)
- The format of references should be revised carefully considering the citation style.

Additional comments along the following lines: originality, literature review, methodology, evaluation of results, research implications, quality of communication, etc.:

- The topic is quite interesting; however, many improvements should be applied, in terms of design and composition itself. This is a problem that affects the whole comprehension of the research:
- The method followed (process) should be better explained in the Abstract, as well as the conclusions of the study; these are not clear.

- The main aim of the study should be stated more clearly. The focus is not clear.
- Grammar, punctuation, and spelling should be carefully revised all throughout the paper.
- The method should present each instrument applied in detail. The research design, as well as the presentation of results, is not clear.
- It is very much recommended to check the use of punctuation to improve coherence and cohesion. Similarly, more connectors, linkers, and transition words should be used to enrich the written composition.
- The number of "Literature Review" should be 2, not 3. Check.

2. Follow APA style strictly for the references. **References must strictly follow APA format 7th edition, otherwise publication will be delayed.**

8. The abstract must be between 175-250 words. The abstract must preferably be in one paragraph only.

9. The conclusion must be between 175-300 words. One or two paragraphs is preferred but not compulsory.

10. All tables and figures must be included at the required locations within the paper. Captions for figures must be placed below the figure while captions for tables must be placed above the table. All table and figure numbers must be included/referenced in the text as well. Ensure that table and figure numbers are not missing.

11. You are **required** to have the paper professionally **edited** before submitting the final revised version.

Evidence in the form of track changes must be provided if editing is done. Editing certificate is not acceptable.
