CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

After analyzing and describing the obtained data in the chapter II and chapter III, then in this chapter there are conclusion and suggestion as the last part of this research. The conclusion below is the answer of the research questions, meanwhile the suggestion is proposed to give information to the readers who are interest in doing further research in this area.

4.1 CONCLUSION

Based on research the finding and discussion about the needs to be an exemplary English teacher in 21st century at Junior High School, it can be concluded that the teachers has a need to be an exemplary English teacher, as for the needs, namely the teacher's need for complete mastery of subject matter, the teacher's need for varied teaching methods, the teacher's need for get clarity of teaching, teacher needs to be able to trigger intellectual enthusiasm among students, teacher needs to be able to use articulateness, teacher needs to be able to respect for students, teacher needs to be concerned and sensitive towards students, teacher needs to get the use of humor, and the teacher's need to be able to cope with unexpected classroom situations such as behavior and attention problems. Therefore, teachers have their own way of meeting their needs to be able to become exemplary English teachers in schools.
