

CHAPTER IV

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

4.1 Conclusion

From the first research question, it can be conclude that the video learning material is ideal for improving listening skills. Video includes both audio and visual elements, making it easier for students to follow. Video can also get students excited about learning and help them understand how to use English in practice. The duration of the video should be considered to avoid students getting oversaturate and dizzy.

Based on the second research question, conclude that the development of this media produces interactive video learning material for 10th grade students at senior high school with the topic of congratulation. The material presented in this video includes an explanation of congratulation, kinds of expressions and responses that can be used, examples of sentences and conversations with expressions of congratulation, and lastly, practice questions to evaluate students' understanding. This media combines audio, video, and images into one and is developed into an interactive video by adding interactive buttons using Adobe Flash CS3 to provide interactivity for students to interact actively with the learning media.

The results of the validation assessment show that the interactive video learning material on the topic of congratulating for 10th grade students in senior high school can be used in the teaching and learning process with the "Very Good" category.

4.2 Suggestion

1. For further research, it is expected to examine the effectiveness of the use of interactive video learning media with the topic of congratulation for grade 10 senior high school students, so that it cannot only be developed but also be obtained as an effective medium to improve student achievement.
2. This learning media is recommended to be used in the learning process on the topic of congratulation because, based on the validation results, it shows that this interactive video learning material is feasible to be used in the learning process on congratulation materials so that it can help teachers explain learning materials and students will also easily understand learning.
3. Suggestions for teachers to learn how to use the Adobe Flash application in order to play the videos and able to explain how to use the application to the students.
